If you have been awarded a handicap (full members only) this is your starting score.

Any player who does not turn up for an arranged match, or who fails to make themselves available to play within the round's time limit without good reason, will forfeit the match. Players forfeiting a match will be given a score of 0 points and their opponents will be awarded 21 points.

A match card should be completed, or some other method of recording the results.
